## **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

**Jumper Shows are covered by the rules and specifications of the current MHSA, USEF 2025 Rule Books. Proper Show attire MUST be Worn (See "Attire" below).**

### **GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:**

No other persons besides show management or their representative may approach the Judge during the show. Questions or concerns should be directed to the Show Steward/Adjudicator. Approaching the Judge prior to the completion of the last class may result in disqualification from the show and/or a possible fine to be determined by the MHSA Awards Committee.

### **MHSA MEMBERSHIP:**

Competitors and horses must be current members of the MHSA in order to qualify for MHSA Year-End Awards. Current membership numbers must be included on entry blanks or a competitor must hand in completed Membership Form prior to competing. (NOTE – ALL JUMPER CLASSES OFFERED AT SHOW COUNT TOWARD MHSA OVERALL RIDER AND HORSE YEAR END AWARDS. NO INDIVIDUAL YEAR END JUMPER AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN DUE TO ONLY HAVING ONE SHOW THIS YEAR)

### **VOLUNTEER SUPPORT:**

MHSA is an all-volunteer organization. We need parents, riders, & supporters to actively help us man the horse shows. Please contact the **Show Manager Lehua Gardanier (phone number 281-3290 or email lkuia@aol.com)** for volunteer opportunities associated with this show.

### **TIES:**

In the case of ties for Championships, winner will be the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences. Should a tie still exist, dual Championships will be awarded and no reserve championship will be given. If a tie exists for reserve championship the winner will be the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences, should a tie still exist, dual reserve championships will be awarded.

### **DEFINITION:**

The Jumper Division is open to riders of any age and horses may be of any type, breed or gender (unless otherwise stated). MHSA prohibits stallions being shown by a rider 17 and under.

### **JUMPER HEIGHT ELIGIBILITY:**

Jumpers are not under the same classification as Hunters, therefore riders are not subject to the same height eligibility requirements as the Hunters. Riders entering in Jumper Show may compete in a lower or a higher height than they are competing in the Hunter Shows. Competing at a different height in the Jumper Show will not affect any Hunter Division eligibility.

### **CROSS ENTRY:**

Any horse may compete in up to two (2) divisions. Refer to USEF Rules regarding eligibility.

Horses per Rider: The number of horses per rider is not limited.

Horse/Rider Combinations are permitted only one division per show. Horse/Rider Combinations are not allowed to cross enter into another division. Once crossover has taken place, rider will not be allowed back into previous division.

### **APPOINTMENTS:**

#### **Tack and Attire:**

##### **Attire:**

Management, at its discretion, may allow competitors to compete without riding coats. If a riding coat is not worn, riders must wear a shirt with a collar or a choker, neatly tucked into riding breeches. Polo Shirts are permitted. A windbreaker jacket or raincoat may be worn if conditions require. In all cases, riders must appear neatly attired to appear before the public or be subject to penalty of elimination by the judges. Tall Boots or Paddock Boots with Half Chaps permitted. Riding Helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.

##### **Formal Attire:**

Only black, dark blue, dark green or scarlet coats are permitted; white breeches (ladies are permitted to wear light tan); a white tie or choker or hunting stock, and a white or lightly colored shirt must be worn.

##### **Martingales:**

Classes offering less than \$1000. - No martingale restrictions.

Classes offering \$1000. to \$4999. - Only standing or running martingales used in the conventional manner are permitted.

##### **Whips:**

Competitors are prohibited from using a whip that is longer than 30" (75cm) while mounted and in the warm-up or competition arenas. A rider may not carry more than one whip. Whips that are weighted at the end are prohibited at any time. A dressage whip may be used when working on the flat.

##### **Draw Reins:**

Draw reins may only be used when schooling, or, in classes with less than \$1000.

**Tied Stirrups:**

Any rider competing with their stirrups tied to the girth and/or secured in any like manner, will automatically be eliminated from that class. Riding anywhere on the competition grounds with stirrups tied to the girth or otherwise secured is cause for elimination by the Steward of that rider from the current or subsequent class in which the rider is entered. In the case of Junior or Amateur riders, the Steward will note the Trainer name(s) on the Steward's Report and further disciplinary actions may be taken by MHSA and USA Equestrian.

**JUMPER DIVISIONS:**

CROSS-RAIL JUMPER: Fences 18"-2'0" maximum. No combinations, triple bars, liverpools or oxers.

RAIN DROP JUMPER: Fences 2'0" to 2'3" maximum. No combinations, triple bars, liverpools or oxers.

PUDDLE JUMPER: Fences 2'3"-2'6" maximum with 2'0" to 2'6" in spread. Gambler's Choice 3'0" maximum. No triple combinations, triple bars or liverpools.

LOW JUMPER: Fences 2'6"-2'9" maximum and 2'6" to 3'0" in spread. Gambler's Choice 3'3" maximum. Triple bars/liverpools up to 3'0".

TRAINING JUMPER: Fences 2'9"-3'0" maximum and 2'9" to 3'3" in spread. Gambler's Choice 3'6" maximum. Triple bars up to 3'6".

OPEN JUMPER: Fences 3'0"-3'6" maximum and 3'6" to 4'6" in spread. Gambler's Choice 4'0" maximum. Triple bars up to 4'0".

**JUMPER CLASSES:**

**Table II Sec 2 (a) / (b)** - Horse and Rider must jump the course set within the time allowed. Fault and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed are added together. Horse and rider with clean rounds may come back to compete in the jump-off. Places are decided by the least amount of faults and fastest time.

**Gambler's Choice:** Each obstacle carries 10 to 120 points according to difficulty. No combination obstacles. Obstacles must be built so they can be jumped in both directions. Horse and Rider will have sixty (60) seconds to jump all the obstacles in any order and any direction they wish. Time will start when they cross the start line. Start line may be crossed in either direction. The Judge will signal when time is up. The horse and rider must then cross the start line (in either direction) to end their time. If the fixed time is reached at the moment the horse is ready to take off, the obstacle counts if jumped correctly. If they do not cross the start line, they place last, with the same number of points. Each obstacle may be jumped ONLY TWICE. If jumped a THIRD time, points do not count. If a rider falls, they must stop, but is still placed according to the number of points awarded. If a jump is knocked down, the points do not count and the jump may not be jumped again. The Joker Fence is worth 200 pts. If it is knocked down, 200 points are deducted. The winner is the competitor with the most points.

**Table 5.1- Optimum Time in First Round:** The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In case of equality of faults, ties will be broken on the following basis: an Optimum Time (defined as 4 sec. less than the Time Allowed for the course) will be posted on the course plan; the horse with the time on course closest to this Optimum Time (over or under) will prevail in the tie, next closest next, etc.

**RULES FOR JUMPER SHOWS**

Knockdown of Obstacle-4 faults

1st Disobedience-4 faults; 2nd Disobedience-4 faults; 3rd Disobedience-Elimination

Time faults assessed for each second or portion thereof exceeding the Time Allowed.

Starting course before Judge's signal-Elimination

Fall of horse or rider - Elimination

Failure To enter ring within one (1) minute of being called - Elimination

You have forty-five (45) sec. to cross the starting line after the Judge's Signal.

**SOUNDNESS:**

All horses must be serviceably sound. Horses being considered for an award may be asked to jog for soundness with rider dismounted.
