Individual Warm Ups: Limit ONE per horse/ride combination per height & Warm Up will be a Shorted course/Pre selected 5 or less fences – will be posted

In Addition To Walk/Trot, Lead Line, Open Equitation, And Open Pleasure & Hunter Hack, Horses May Be Shown In up to Two (2) Hunter Divisions, But ONLY With DIFFERENT RIDERS.

Walk/Trot And Short Stirrup (Riders 17 & Under) and Long Stirrup (Riders 18 & Over) MAY NOT Cross Enter.

Non Judged Entries MAY NOT Enter Walk/Trot Or Short/Long Stirrup Flat Classes.

Open Warm Up in Show Arena ½ hour (Permitted to jumping outside lines. NO individual warm up prior to Jumper Classes)

HUNTER DIVISIONS RULES:

WALK/TROT 13 & UNDER: Designed for the beginning rider 13 years and under (as of January 1), This class is to be shown at a walk and trot only, in both directions of the arena. Obstacle Course to be shown at trot over a minimum of six (6) ground poles. Professionals may NOT enter this division.

WALK/TROT 14 & OVER: Designed for he beginning rider 14 years and over (as of January 1), In the Walk/Trot 14 & Over, also permitted is the beginning horse or horses returning after a two – year hiatus who are not yet ready to canter in a group, if ridden by a rider 14 & Over. This class is to be shown at a walk and trot only, in both directions of the arena. Obstacle Course to be shown at trot over a minimum of six (6) ground poles. Professionals may NOT enter this division.

18" SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER: Designed for the beginning rider 17 and under (as of January 1). Shown over a minimum of Six (6) fences. Simple Changes are permitted & are not to be penalized. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May not be asked to hand gallop. Riders not allowed to cross enter into another division. Once crossover has taken place, rider will not be allowed back into Short Stirrup. Professionals may NOT enter this division.

18" LONG STIRRUP HUNTER: Designed for the beginning rider 18 and over (as of January 1), and the Beginning Horse, in their first or second year of showing in an MHSA Hunter Show (excluding Walk/Trot division), and riders OR horses returning after a two – year hiatus that are able to canter in a group. Shown over a minimum of six (6) fences. Simple Changes are permitted & are not to be penalized. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May not be asked to hand gallop. Riders not allowed to cross enter into another division. Once crossover has taken place, rider will not be allowed back into Long Stirrup. Professionals may NOT enter this division.

2'0" GREEN HORSE/GREEN RIDER HUNTER: For horses and riders that have never jumped a course of higher than 2'0" in an MHSA, HHSA or USEF sanctioned Hunter Show. Horses and riders may stay in this division for two (2) years or until they have won a year-end division championship. Professionals may enter this division if riding a Green Horse (by definition). Shown over a minimum of eight (8) fences. Simple Changes are permitted & are not to be penalized. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May not be asked to hand gallop. If a horse or rider moves to a higher height division, they will not be allowed back into this division and Green Horse/Green Rider points will be forfeited.

2'3" HUNTER: Open to all Horses and small & medium Ponies to jump a minimum of eight (8) fences. Hunter Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. Not to hand gallop. Small & Medium Ponies are defined as those that do not exceed 13.2 hands. Professionals may enter this division.

2'6" HUNTER: Open to all Horses and Large Ponies to jump a minimum of eight (8) fences. Hunter Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. Not to hand gallop. Large Ponies are defined as those that are over 13.2 and do not exceed 14.2 hands. Professionals may enter this division.

2'9" HUNTER: Open to all horses and riders of any age to jump a minimum of eight (8) obstacles. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May be asked to hand gallop. Emphasis on manners, extreme speed to be penalized. Professionals may enter this division.

3'0" HUNTER: Open to all horses and riders of any age to jump a minimum of eight (8) obstacles. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May be asked to hand gallop. Emphasis on manners, extreme speed to be penalized. Professionals may enter this division.

3'3" – 3'6" HUNTER: Open to all horses and riders of any age to jump a minimum of eight (8) fences. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena. May be asked to hand gallop. Emphasis is on manners, extreme speed to be penalized. Professionals may enter this division.

SHORT STIRRUP & LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION: Flat – to be shown at a walk, trot and canter, in both directions of the arena. Over Fences – 18" to be shown over a minimum of six (6) fences.

All MHSA MEDAL EQUITATION CLASSES - Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 3" above selected Medal Class Height at the same show. At least three riders without major faults, if available, will be asked to work off. Judges must select at least two tests from USEF Equitation Tests 1 through 5 and 8. NOTE: There is no cross entry between Medal classes at the same competition.

OPEN EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for additional tests to be performed, including a change of mounts.

OPEN PLEASURE: Open to riders and horses of all ages. The English Pleasure Horse is defined as any type, breed or gender (unless otherwise stated). MHSA prohibits stallions being shown by a rider 17 and under. It is imperative that the horse has the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride and display a pleasurable attitude. All gaits must be performed with willingness and obvious ease, cadence, balance and smoothness. Shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena, with emphasis on manners and the ability to afford a pleasurable ride. Conformation is not to count.

OPEN HUNTER HACK: To be shown at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the arena and required to jump two (2) fences, 2'3" in height. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. Martingales are prohibited in this division. Classes: Hunter Hack and English Pleasure Hack. Horses showing in Pleasure Hack must have shown in Hunter Hack.

ALL HUNTER UNDER SADDLE & EQUITATION ON THE FLAT CLASSES : Martingales are prohibited in these classes.

PERSONAL:

Riders should wear conservative jackets, breeches or jodhpurs, boots or jodhpur boots. ASTM Certified Helmets are required for all riders when mounted. Spurs, crops and bats are optional.

TACK:

Bridle should be of show type, curb or single snaffle, curb and snaffle, or pelham, with a cavesson noseband. Judges can penalize, at their discretion, a horse with a non-conventional noseband, bit or bridle.

Martingales of any type are prohibited in Under Saddle, hack and tie-breaking classes. Standing martingales are allowed for all over fence classes. All other martingales may be considered unconventional. Saddle should be any English type saddle. Girth may be of leather, web, or string. No boots or bandages are allowed except in Equitation, & Jumpers. Note: Any unconventional use tack will be subject to the judge's discretion.

IUMPER DIVISIONS RULES:

Open to riders and horses of all ages regardless of height entered in Hunter Divisions. Jumper Classes will not affect Hunter Eligibility.

70m-.75/80m (2'3"-2'6") 85m - .90/.95m (2'6"-2'9")

Table II Sec 2 (a) / (b) - Horse and Rider must jump the course set within the time allowed. Fault and any penalties for exceeding the time allowed are added together. Horse and rider with clean rounds may come back to compete in the jump-off. Places are decided by the least amount of faults and fastest time.

Gambler's Choice: Each obstacle carries 10 to 120 points according to difficulty. No combination obstacles. Obstacles must be built so they can be jumped in both directions. Horse and Rider will have sixty (60) seconds to jump all the obstacles in any order and any direction they wish. Time will start when they cross the start line. Start line may be crossed in either direction. The Judge will signal when time is up. The horse and rider must then cross the start line (in either direction) to end their time. If the fixed time is reached at the moment the horse is ready to take off, the obstacle counts if jumped correctly. If they do not cross the start line, they place last, with the same number of points. Each obstacle may be jumped ONLY TWICE. If jumped a THIRD time, points do not count. If a rider falls, they must stop, but is still placed according to the number of points awarded. If a jump is knocked down, the points do not count and the jump may not be jumped again. The Joker Fence is worth 200 pts. If it is knocked down, 200 points are deducted. The winner is the competitor with the most points.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

No other persons besides show management or their representative may approach the Judge during the show. Questions or concerns should be directed to the Show Steward/Adjudicator. Approaching the Judge prior to the completion of the last class may result in disqualification from the show and/or a possible fine to be determined by the MHSA Awards Committee.

MHSA MEMBERSHIP:

Competitors and horses must be current members of the MHSA in order to qualify for MHSA Year-End Awards. Current membership numbers must be included on entry blanks or a competitor must hand in completed Membership Form prior to competing. (NOTE – ALL CLASSES & DIVISIONS OFFERED AT SHOW COUNT TOWARD MHSA YEAR END AWARDS)

VOLUNTEER SUPPORT:

MHSA is an all-volunteer organization. We need parents, riders, & supporters to actively help us man the horse shows. Please contact the **Show Manager Lehua Gardanier (phone number 281-3290 or email lkuia@aol.com)** for volunteer opportunities associated with this show.

TIES:

In the case of ties for Championships, winner will be the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences. Should a tie still exist, dual Championships will be awarded and no reserve championship will be given. If a tie exists for reserve championship the winner will be the horse that has accumulated the most points over fences, should a tie still exist, duel reserve championships will be awarded


